Our Westfield FRIA application is approved. The AMA is continuing to work with the federal government to expand the altitude limit at FRIA approved sites in class G airspace. They also got approval for a procedure to allow for events at non FRIA sites to be exempt from the RemoteID requirement. Jim Porter is continuing to work on RemoteID related issues to gain a better understanding of how the devices work.

AMA will notify clubs on the status of their grant requests in May.

Mild weather in Iowa has allowed our members to get out and get some flying in. Members on WhatsApp are posting about the new planes they have built over the winter. I have included some pictures.

Our public training sessions will be starting after Memorial Day and run to Labor Day. Training night will be Monday night at both fields this year. We have submitted a grant request to AMA to upgrade equipment at both fields. We will use this money in addition to our own money to make needed upgrades to our training equipment. Also, we are asking for more members to help with the training programs. You can volunteer as a helper or as an instructor. Several of our current instructors have been doing this for a long


